

Lincoln Mark VII Vehicle Certification Label

VEHICLE CERTIFICATION LABEL – The Vehicle Certification Label, also known as the VC or information sticker, is located on the driver's side doorframe. The upper half of the label the name of the manufacturer, month and year of manufacture, Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) and the certification statement. The VC also contains the 17-character Vehicle Identification Number (VIN). This is the definitive identifier of the vehicle based on it's production information. The VIN describes manufacturer, type of seat belts, line, series, body type, engine, model year, and consecutive production number. Lincoln Mark VII production numbers range from 600001 through 999999. The VC also contains the option information for body color, body type, molding, interior trim, radio type, sunroof, axle, transmission, district, and special order numbers.
